

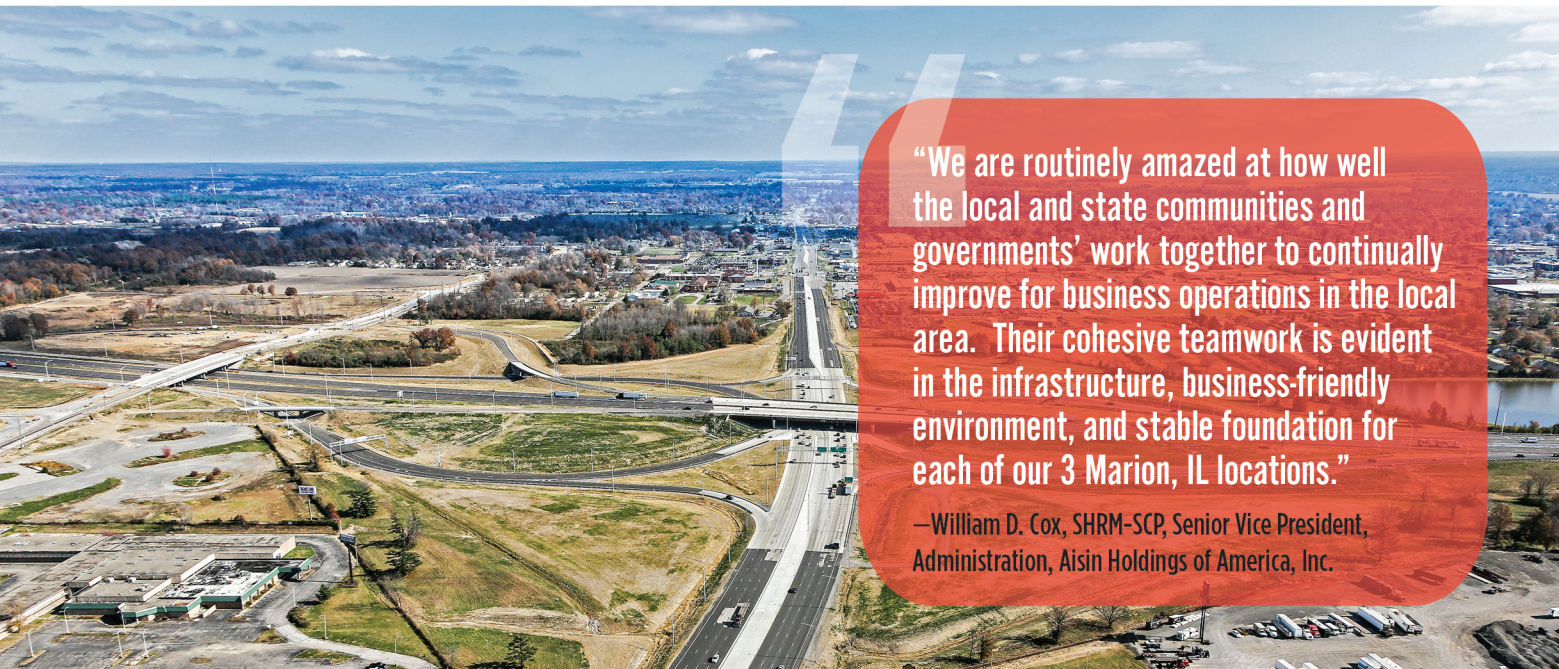
SOUTHERN ILLINOIS
